May 5, 2019 – Third Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41

Called a second time before the Sanhedrin, Israel's ruling body, Peter and the apostles speak bravely of God's call to them to preach about Jesus as all-important.

Second Reading: Revelation 5:11-14

Praise from great numbers of beings combined with the prostration of the elders recall the honor usually paid to the emperor. The author's vision involves a conflict between God's rule and Caesar's.

Gospel: John 21:1-19, or 21:1-14

After a miraculous catch of fish, the Beloved Disciple recognizes the stranger on the shore. Then the risen Jesus cooks a breakfast for His chosen friends. Peter receives a pardon for his triple denial on the night before the crucifixion by his three professions of love. Jesus then entrusts Peter with the care of His flock.

Reflection:

The sheep Jesus is sending us to feed and care for might not be very far away: in the next room, at school, work, across the street, or the other side of town. Our prayer response at this Eucharist could be, "Here I am the Lord, ready to do your will." Then, we listen to his response and go where he is sending us to feed his sheep.

So we ask ourselves:

- Who are the sheep Jesus is sending me to feed and care for?
- Where do I find nourishment to help me fulfill his mandate?

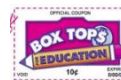
