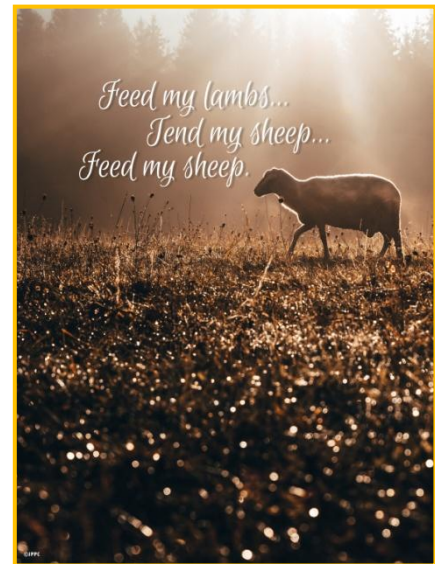

May 12, 2019 – Fourth Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52

Antioch was the locale of Roman provincial headquarters, so it was an active city with a large Jewish population. Paul and Barnabas go there to proclaim God’s Word to both Jews and Gentiles. However, the Jews turned persecutors, so the two men preached mainly to Gentiles before being forced to flee.

Second Reading: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

This scene describes the salvation of multitudes of the righteous people. They are described here as holding up the palm fronds of victory as they sing about it.

Gospel: John 10:27-30

The shepherd image returns to John’s gospel narrative. God has given the “flock” to Jesus so that no one can take it from Him, not even religious leaders claiming to act in God’s name. The unity of Father and Son includes the community of believers.

Reflection:

Imagine what an inmate in one of our violent prisons (and most prisons are!) must endure trying to practice their faith. At Easter time converts to the faith were baptized in prison chapels throughout the country. We pray with them that Christ will shepherd them and that God will wipe away their tears

So we ask ourselves:

- To whom can I be a comforting and shepherding presence?
- Is my heart as open to all people as God’s?
