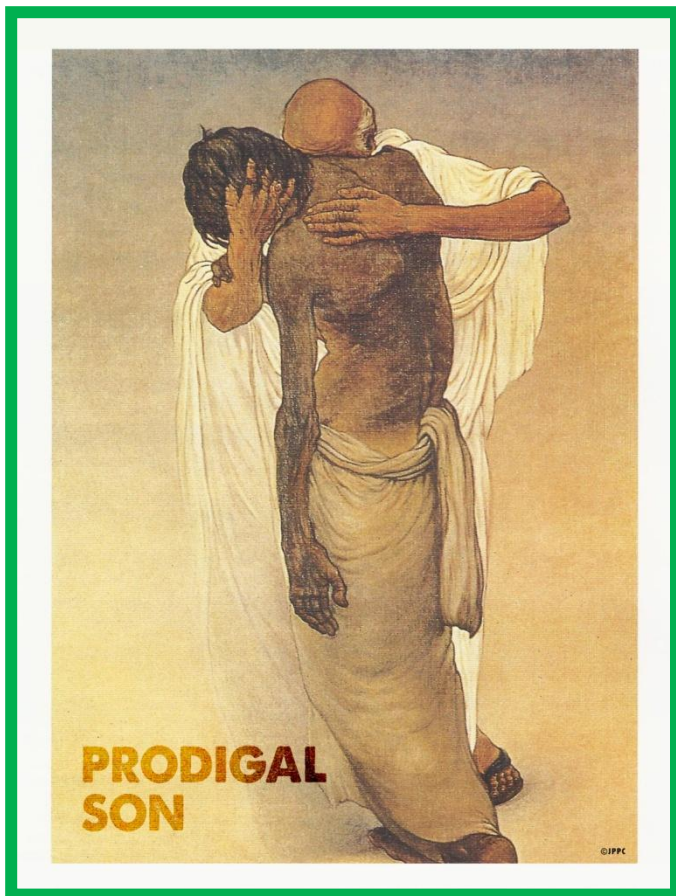

## September 11, 2022 – Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### First Reading: Exodus 32: 7-11, 13-14

Yahweh tells Moses, still on the mountaintop, about His people's apostasy down below, and His plan to destroy them. But Moses intercedes and persuades Yahweh to relent and remember His promises to the patriarchs.

### Second Reading: I Timothy 1: 12-17

Paul, using himself as an example, boldly asserts to Timothy his friend that "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners."

### Gospel: Luke 15: 1-32, or 15: 1-10


Luke selects three of Jesus' parables to illustrate how God's mercy allows Him to delight in people who turn back to Him after they have made bad choices to sin.

### Reflection:

Like the boy in the parable, who went off to a "distant land," when we have wandered from God grace stirs up a longing in us to return "home." Then grace enables us to turn around and make the sometimes arduous journey to our true dwelling place with God. Thanks to grace, we find we can do what has seemed impossible. Grace is not defined in the Bible, but is at the heart of every biblical story and our story as well.

### So, we ask ourselves:

- What surprising and unexpected experience of grace have I had recently?
- To whom am I being sent to be the face of grace in their lives?
