First Reading: Acts 1: 12-14

Having witnessed Jesus' Ascension, the remaining Apostles, now minus Judas, gather for support and prayer in the Upper Room, anticipating the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Second Reading: I Peter 4: 13-16

Facing persecution realistically, the author urges the Christian community to be proud of any suffering they endure for Christ.

Gospel: John 17: 1-11a


In His great prayer, Jesus acknowledges that His work has been completed, and now "the hour has come" for Him to return to His Father.

Reflection:

What can be so "glorious" about the death of this good man Jesus? What is there to stand up and cheer about? Maybe, because in his death, people will see how much he trusted God. He remained faithful, even through his pain and death. That's something to cheer about. Glory to God!

So we ask ourselves:

- How would you describe the "glory of God?"
- Does that glory show itself frequently in our world? Can you give a few examples?
